The Lead Teacher is responsible for lesson planning, organizing, managing, and teaching Bible lessons, social skills, and providing academic help for up to forty 4th through 6th -grade students in our Palomino (North Phoenix) Afterschool Program.

We seek highly motivated individuals with previous teaching experience who can manage and encourage positive student behavior, organize volunteer schedules, and is passionate about working with youth, families, and the community. Our Afterschool and Summer Program focus on Academic Success, Leadership Development, Spiritual Growth, as well as, offering fun activities such as sports and crafts.

This position is part-time requiring up to 20 hours a week for After-School and up to 25 hours per week during summer.

Summer Program (June) Monday – Thursday, 9:00am-3:00pm
