Job Description

MentorKids USA is currently seeking a Lead Teacher for our K-4th grade classrooms who will be responsible for lesson planning, organizing, managing, and teaching Bible lessons, social skills, and sport activities for up to 40 K-4th grade students in our Afterschool Program held in the South Phoenix neighborhood. We are seeking an initiative-taking individual with previous teaching experience who can manage and encourage positive student behavior, organize volunteer schedules, and is enthusiastic about working with youth, families, and the community. Our Afterschool Program focuses on spiritual growth, academic success, and leadership development. This position is part time, 2:00pm - 6:30pm, Monday thru Friday requiring up to 29 hours a week with commensurate pay based upon professional experience.

Schedule, and Hours

1. School/Summer Program Hours
(Monday-Friday 2pm-6:30pm subject to change) Some Saturday or Sunday with advanced notice. This is a Part-Time position, not to exceed 29.5 hours per week with potential to turn into a full-time position
2. Paycheck will be mailed or sent via direct deposit on the 5th and the 20th of each month.
3. Time off must be approved by Neighborhood Manager two weeks in advance, excluding illness.

Responsibilities

- Create lessons plans and teach daily Bible Lesson, Social Skills, and Teamwork Activities to ensure student success and MKUSA core values.
- Provide Leadership and direction for Assistant Teachers and 2-4 daily iLEADers
- Coordinate and manage weekly iLEAD schedules
- Meet bi-weekly with K-8th Program Coordinator.
- Prepare monthly written reports on program and student progress.

Qualifications

- Minimum 2 years professional teaching experience preferred (Current license/certification not needed).

- Demonstrate a vibrant and growing Christian faith.
- Must be a collaborator, an effective communicator, and demonstrate good organizational skills.
- Must have an Arizona driver's license and be able to pass a fingerprint clearance.
